What is parental involvement under No Child Left Behind?

Parental involvement has always been a centerpiece of Title I. However, for the first time in the history of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), it has a specific statutory definition. The statute defines parental involvement as the participation of parents in regular, two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring—



- that parents play an integral role in assisting their child’s learning;
- that parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child’s education at school; and
- that parents are full partners in their child’s education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child.¹

The first step toward successful parental involvement is open and positive communication among parents, Title I teachers, and staff members. Parents and guardians of Title I students should feel welcome to contact either their child’s Title I teacher, or staff members at the Title I main office, at any time. If no one is available to take your call, please leave a message on the voice mailbox, and the party will return your call as soon as possible. E-mail will be checked on days when school is in session.
