

7B Guidelines

Absences:

Students are required to return to school with an absent note and stay after school the day they return from an absence. If the return day falls on a Friday, plan to stay the next Monday.

Make up work:

A student missing one or two days of school will have one week from the day they return to make up missed assignments.

In the case of extended absences (3+days), the student will have two weeks from the return day to make up assignments. (*Special circumstances will be dealt with on an individual basis.*)

Missing/Late assignments:

If an assignment is not passed in on its due date (not due to absence), students will lose 10 pts off for each day late. Credit will not be given after one week and assignment will be averaged as a 0%.

Rewrites:

If a student is given the opportunity to rewrite an assignment, the improved assignment must be passed in within one week of receiving initial grade.

Binder:

Each student should have a three ring binder with dividers for each subject: English, Science, Math, and Social Studies.

After School:

Each teacher has two after school sessions. Plan on staying with a teacher(s) if you are absent, need extra help, or need to organize your binder.
