Academic Support Program for Mathematics (MCAS Prep)

Teachers are needed for **The MCAS Math Prep Program**. This program is designed to prepare sophomore students to successfully pass (240 or above is the required score) the grade 10 MCAS exam in mathematics that will be administered this spring. Students are selected to participate based on grade 8 MCAS scores. Students who scored in *Warning* and *Needs Improvement* categories on previous MCAS or students who are new to the school district are eligible for the program.

There is also a need for tutors (mathematics) for students who are juniors, seniors, or have exited the high school and are preparing for the MCAS retest.

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with Program Coordinators and administration
- Review of MCAS item analysis to prepare targeted assistance for individual students
- Work with curriculum director related to program instruction
- Administer and correct pre and post tests
- Complete all reports and maintain required program records
- Communicate progress of students with regular classroom teachers

Requirements:

- Licensed Math teachers (teachers who are licensed in SPED and/or ELL are also needed for the program)

Hours:

- After School Programs: Math – 20 hours
Mondays and Wednesdays 2:30- 3:30
February 13 – May 9
- Saturday Program: Math -20 hours 10:00 A.M.- noon
March 3 - May 12 (excluding April 21)
- Tutors have a flexible schedule that make up 20 hours of instruction

Stipend:

- \$33.00/ hour (includes planning time)
