- String Orchestra is addressed to students who have at least two years of prior instruction on a string instrument.
- Emphasis will be on the development of technical skills, reading skills, ensemble skills, and musicianship.

 - Artistic perception – to develop critical listening skills
 - Artistic reflection – to cultivate critical thinking skills.
