

**Acceptable Use Agreement for Parents using the iParent System within
the Medford Public School System**

- The sole purpose of iParent is to review information related only to my child or children. I understand that student information should be kept confidential.
- As parent/guardian, I will register with an appropriate username and password. One parent registration will be used for all students in the family. I will not use another username or password registered to another individual.
- I accept that it is my sole responsibility to protect the security of this username and password. The district accepts no responsibility in the event the username and password is shared, given, stolen, or in any other way becomes the possession of another person other than the assigned parent/guardian.
- In the event my password becomes comprised, I will change it immediately.
- I understand that I have three attempts to enter my username and password correctly and if unable to do so my account will become inactive and I will need to contact the iPass administrator.
- I accept that the primary use of computer resources and the Internet is to support my child's education. I will follow all copyright regulations and will not copy programs or pirate software.
- I will not invade the privacy of others or access the network or files of any business, person, or agency with intent to steal, subvert, destroy, or view information that is not appropriate.
- I understand that electronic mail (e-mail) is not guaranteed to be private. People who operate the system have access to all mail and that all Internet activity can be monitored. Information that is personal in nature will not be communicated via email.
- I will be polite and use appropriate language. I will not swear, use vulgarities, harass others, use ethnic or racial slurs, access inappropriate websites, engage in hacking or vandalism, or transmit or view obscene or offensive material.
- I will not degrade or disrupt school or Internet network services or equipment, as such activity is considered a crime under state and federal law; this includes but is not limited to tampering with computer hardware and software, vandalizing data, invoking computer viruses or attempting to gain access to restricted or unauthorized network services.
- I understand and agree with the school district contract for computer use in the schools and that the Medford School District will cooperate fully with local, state or federal officials in any investigation concerning or relating to misuse of the district's system or network.
- I understand that should I break this contract my access to my iParent account will be terminated.
