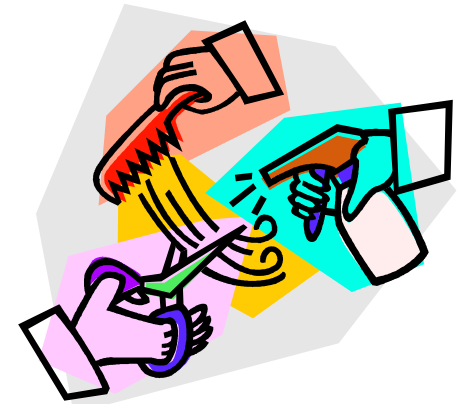

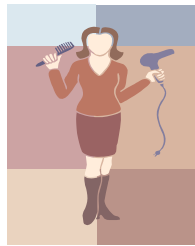
## Cosmetology Course of Study

The Medford Vocational - Technical High School Cosmetology course of study contains the following elements:

### The Program

The Cosmetology program for post-graduate study is a ten month program preparing the student for the Massachusetts licensing examination, upon completion of 1000 hours. The program boasts a 100% success rate for graduates who pass the examination.



Students study all aspects of the cosmetology field including, manicuring, hair coloring, permanent waving, cutting, professional ethics, salon management and sanitation.

Students who have achieved 500 hours will work on patrons who visit the school.



The Cosmetology Department keeps current with the latest trends in fashion and hair-styling by participation in field trips to trade shows and by maintaining close contact with members of the program advisory board. Advisory board members are professionals currently working in the field of cosmetology who give counsel and advice to insure the program is current and satisfies the needs of the students and the industry.

### Who is eligible?

High School graduates are eligible or students eligible for a GED to enroll in this full day program. Classes are 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

### Cost

- \$1500 registration fee required (applied toward tuition.)
- Medford residents are charged \$5000 tuition for the Postgraduate Program, while non-residents are charged \$6000.
- Classes are 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

### Application

- Applicants interested in participating in the program will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. Limited space is available.
- Anyone desiring more information on the program should contact the Admissions Office at 781-393-2207. Interviews available upon request with the Cosmetology instructors.
- Accepted students must present a birth certificate and a health certificate prior to entering.
