Medford Public Schools Instructors for Summer School 2017

Summer school is for those students in grades 6-12 who have failed a course during the regular school year and need to make the course up for credit. Courses in the academic areas of English, mathematics, science, social studies and Spanish are offered. Summer school is organized into two classes per day. (8:00 a.m. - 10:00 and 10:05- 12:05 p.m) The dates for summer school are M-F June 26 - August 8 (No classes Monday- Tuesday July 3- July 4)

This year there will be two formats for the program-

High School Program- Students grades 8-12

Courses will be offered using Edmentum online learning. There will be one teacher facilitator for each content area to supervise and assist students taking courses in that content area. Teachers will be trained in the online system prior to the beginning of summer school.

Middle School Program- Students grades 6-7

Teachers will work with groups of students on instruction related to specific areas of the curriculum not mastered during the school year. The program will consist of 1 ½ hrs of instruction with a 45 minute activity period prior to the start of session 2

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree, Masters preferred
- Massachusetts licensure in the appropriate subject and/or grade level
- Familiarity with online learning preferred- high school program
- Supervision of 45 minute activity- middle school program.

Responsibilities

- Develop and Implement the program curriculum
- Collaborate with program staff and curriculum directors
- Complete all reports, maintain necessary records
- Report to the program Coordinator
- Attend meetings associated with the program
